DO YOU KNOW WHAT TO DO WHEN SOMEONE

Do you know what sudden cardiac arrest (SCA) is?

What it's NOT

SCA is NOT a heart attack — it's worse.

A heart attack occurs when blood supply to the heart muscle is blocked, but the heart keeps beating.



What it IS

SCA occurs when the **heart's electrical system** goes haywire (ventricular fibrillation) and stops blood flow from the heart.



The Facts

SCA strikes suddenly (hence the name).

Anyone, anywhere, anytime — even if they appear healthy.

The heart begins **quivering** during sudden cardiac arrest.







Compression-Only CPR can double or even triple

How do I help?

If you see someone suddenly collapse, **call 9-1-1** and then **push hard and fast** in the center of the chest. Giving good chest compressions is tiring. When others can help, switch chest compressors about every 2 minutes until EMS personnel take over.



If an automated external defibrillator (AED) becomes available, turn it on immediately and follow the voice instructions.

CPR and Defibrillation before EMS arrives will **help save lives.**
